NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF NORTH DEVON LOCAL PLAN

On 6 July 2006 North Devon District Council adopted the above Plan. The adopted Plan will form part of the development plan for the area of North Devon District. The development plan forms the basis for decisions on land use planning affecting that area.

Copies of the adopted Plan are available for public inspection at the Planning Reception, Civic Centre, Barnstaple during office hours from the date of this Notice. The adopted Local Plan is also available for public inspection at the Ilfracombe Community Office, 44 High Street, Ilfracombe and the South Molton Community Office, 11/12 George Arcade, South Molton during their normal opening times. Alternatively, you can view the Plan on the District Council's website www.northdevon.gov.uk.

The Plan came into operation on its adoption. A person aggrieved by the proposals who desires to question their validity on the ground that they are not within the powers conferred by Part II of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 or that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the proposals, may, within six weeks from the date of this Notice, make an application to the High Court under section 287 of the 1990 Act.
