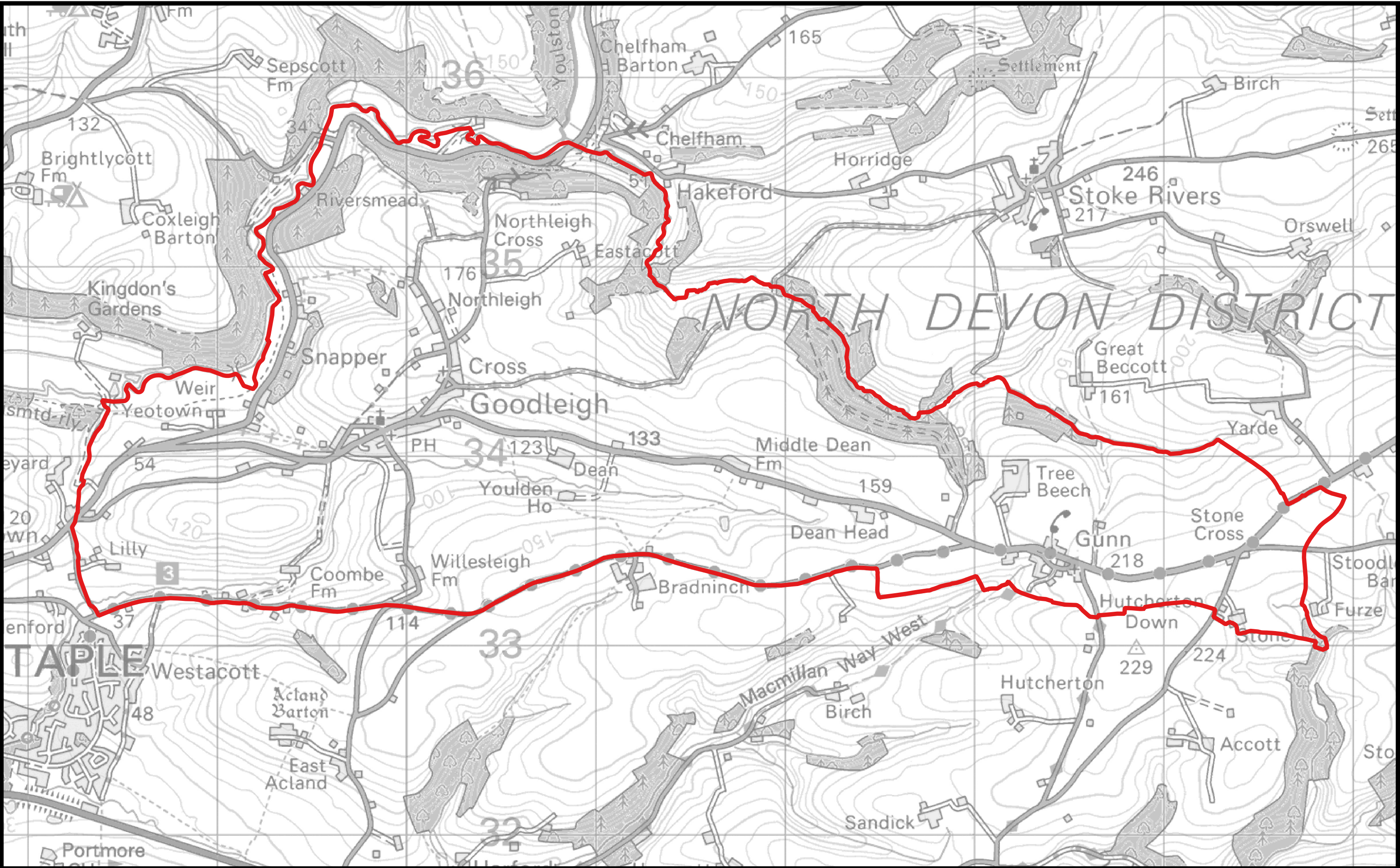


REDESIGNATION OF THE GOODLEIGH PARISH BOUNDARY

Goodleigh Parish Council wish to apply to have the area shown outlined in red on the attached map designated as a Neighbourhood Area in accordance with the provisions of Part 2 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. The area, outlined in red on the enclosed map is appropriate for designation because it is the entire Parish of Goodleigh and following consultation with the residents of Gunn and at their request now includes the village of Gunn. The Gunn residents requested that their village be incorporated into the Parish of Goodleigh as they believed that their needs and the issues facing them as a community were more closely aligned with those of the Parish of Goodleigh than the Parish of Swimbridge. Goodleigh village is the main settlement in the Parish, which also includes the areas of Snapper and Northleigh. This area is considered appropriate as a Neighbourhood Area, having been the subject of development proposals during the emerging North Devon and Torridge Local Plan. It is considered important that development meets the views, needs and aspirations of the whole parish of Goodleigh. It is confirmed that Goodleigh Parish Council is a relevant body for the purposes of Section 61(G) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990
