#### SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

<u>To:</u> M. Rickard, Mobile Cafe, Layby on A39 adjacent to ATTURM, Instow, North Devon.

## WHEREAS

- (1) It appears to North Devon District Council ("the Council"), being the local planning authority for the purposes of Section 3 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1984 ("the Act") in this matter, that development of Crown land has been carried out, otherwise than by or on behalf of the Crown, at a time when no person is entitled to occupy it by virtue of a private interest (including a licence in writing). The land or premises ("the land") is described in schedule 1 below.
- (2) The matters alleged to constitute development are described in Schedule 2 below.
- (3) The Council consider it expedient, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to any other material considerations, to issue this notice (a "special enforcement notice") in exercise of their powers contained in Section 3 of the Act for the reasons set out in the annex to this Notice.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council require that the steps specified in Schedule 3 below be taken in order to discontinue any use of the land which has been instituted by the development within the period of 14 days from the date on which this notice takes effect.

THIS NOTICE SHALL TAKE EFFECT, subject to the provisions of Section 88(10) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 (as applied by Section 3(8) of the Act) on 1st July 1988.

### ANNEX TO AN ENFORCEMENT NOTICE DATED


- 1. Following complaint received during the summer and autumn of 1987, investigations have been made into the siting of a mobile canteen on a layby at Instow on the A39 opposite to the Army Training Base.
- 2. The mobile canteen takes the form of a caravan which is parked on the layby at all times. During clement weather a metal table together with chairs are also sited next to the caravan in the layby.
- 3. The area around the caravan is, on occasion, cluttered with gas canisters, water bottles and rubbish sacks.
- 4. The owner of the caravan has no planning consent in respect of the change of use of the land for the stationing of a mobile caravan for the sale of refreshments.
- 5. Were planning consent applied for it would be refused on the following grounds:
  - (a) The general appearance, associated advertising and bold lettering used in the advertisements for the cafe are detrimental visually in this setting.
  - (b) The siting of the cafe interferes with the function of the layby by taking up parking spaces which could otherwise be used by vehicles.


