Basic facts about North Devon District


This report provides a summary of the latest available information on the demographic and socio-economic make-up of the North Devon district within Devon county. It looks at the population structure and provides information on the economic, housing and educational achievement of the district.

North Devon is one of the 8 Districts of Devon. It has an area of <u>108,605 hectares</u> which represents <u>16.54%</u> of the total area of Devon county .

Residents



The resident population of North Devon in 2020 was $\underline{98,170}$ which represents $\underline{12.11\%}$ of the total Devon county resident population of $\underline{810,716}$.

North Devon's resident population is <u>49,986</u> (<u>50.9 people (per 100 people</u>)) female and <u>48,184</u> (<u>49.1</u> <u>people (per 100 people</u>)) male.


North Devon has <u>3,910</u> households with dependent children aged 0 to 4. That represents <u>9.80%</u> of the district's households. <u>10,431</u> households in the district have dependent children of all ages. That represents <u>26.10%</u> of the district's households.

Age

The predominant age band in North Devon in 2020 was 'population aged 55-59' with <u>7,646 people</u> out of the total population of <u>98,170</u>.

The mean age of the North Devon district population was <u>43</u> years compared to a mean age of <u>44</u> years for residents in the whole of Devon in 2011.






Ethnicity



The largest ethnic group in N Devon is 'Number of usual residents who are White' with <u>97.9%</u> of the district's population. That compares with a figure of <u>97.5%</u> for Devon county as a whole and <u>95.4%</u> for South West .

The second largest ethnic group is 'Number of usual residents who are Asian/Asian British' with 0.9% of the district's population. That compares with 1.2% for the county as a whole and 2.0% for South West.


The ethnic split of North Devon's residents is shown below.



Households

In 2021 North Devon district had <u>43,200</u> households, which represent <u>12.25%</u> of Devon's <u>352,600</u> households. The household split by tenure is shown below.






The largest number of households lives in households owned outright (%) accommodation with 39.1% of N Devon households. That compares with 40.4% for Devon county as a whole and 32.5% for South West.

The second largest number of households lives in households owned with a mortgage or loan (%) accommodation with 29.4% of the district's households. That compares with 29.8% for the county as a whole and 35.1% for South West.


In N Devon the Overall employment rate (aged 16-64) in 2022 Q2 (12 months ending) was <u>83.9%</u> compared to <u>77.3%</u> in Devon and <u>78.4%</u> in South West. The chart above provides a breakdown of North Devon district by occupation for all residents aged 16 – 74 in 2021 Q4 (12 months ending).

Education





<u>22.90%</u> of North Devon's residents have achieved level 4 qualifications and above compared to <u>27.80%</u> in Devon as a whole and <u>24.10%</u> of North Devon's residents have no qualifications compared to <u>21.10%</u> in Devon.

Health




In 2011 North Devon had <u>4,064</u> (<u>4.3 people (per 100 people</u>)) residents that reported being in bad health and <u>1,194</u> (<u>1.3%</u>) residents that reported being in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 6 (out of 8 Districts) within Devon.
