VISITOR MOORINGS

- All visitor pick-up moorings are yellow and are clearly marked with a black V for Visitor.
 The Red mooring buoys in the outer harbour are for use by the resident working vessels.
- Do not moor on any working (C) or fishing berths / pick-up moorings without permission from the Harbour Office.
- There are a limited number of wall moorings in the inner harbour, which are generally reserved for fin keel and long keel vessels.
- When coming ashore, do not leave unattended dinghies tied to, or obstructing landings, as they are in constant use by pleasure and commercial vessels.
- Always let go of the downwind rope first when vacating the berth.
- This allows for the easy reattachment of the mooring rig even when single handed.
