TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER,
1963

DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Minister of Housing and Local Government has approved a Direction dated the 13th day of May, 1965, made by the Devon County Council as local planning authority under Article 4 of the above-mentioned Order, the effect of which is to prohibit the use of land for any purpose on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use permitted by Article 3 and the First Schedule (Class IV.2.) of the above-mentioned Order unless planning permission therefor is granted on application made in that behalf.

A copy of the said Direction and the plan defining the land to which it relates may be seen between 9 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays at Room G.35, County Hall, Exeter, and at the offices of the Barnstaple Rural District Council, The Red House, Castle Street, Barnstaple.

The said Direction will come into force on the 21st day of August, 1965, and relates to the following:-

Woolacombe on the seaward side of The Esplanade together with the Putting Green and land south and west thereof as shown coloured pink on the plan above referred to.

Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963

The area of land forming the greensward between the Esplanade and the Beach and including the putting green at Woolacombe in the Barnstaple Rural District

WHEREAS the County Council of the Administrative County of Devon being the local planning authority for the said County are satisfied that it is expedient that the development specified in the Schedule hereto falling within Class IV.2. of the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 should not be carried out in the area of land coloured pink on the plan annexed hereto unless permission is granted on application in that behalf under the provisions of the said Order

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development specified in the Schedule hereto in the said area of land

THE SCHEDULE

Class IV.2. - Temporary buildings and uses

The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building or the site or curtilage of a building which has been demolished in consequence of war damage) for any purpose except as a caravan site on not more than twenty eight days in total in any calendar year and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use
