WHEREAS the North Devon District Council being the Local Planning Authority for the said District are satisfied that it is expedient that development specified in the first part of the Schedule hereto being development within Class IV(2) of the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (as amended), should not be carried out in the areas of land which are shewn coloured edged red on the plan hereunto annexed and described in the second part of the Schedule hereto unless permission is granted on application in that behalf under the provisions of the said Order NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 (as amended) hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development specified in part One of the said Schedule hereto in respect of the said areas of land.

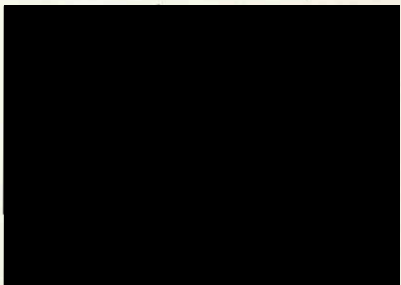
