Air Quality Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

Adoption Statement

In accordance with the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) notice is hereby given that the Air Quality Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was adopted by North Devon Council and Torridge District Council on 5th October 2020.

The draft Air Quality SPD was published for public consultation between 26th September 2019 and 8th November 2019. Under Section 23 (1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, the Council has modified the SPD to take into account representations made in relation to the draft document and any other relevant matters. The adopted SPD is now a material consideration in the determination of relevant planning applications.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted. The SPD, an updated Consultation Statement (summarising the main issues raised during the formal consultation period and how these were addressed) and this Adoption Statement are all available to view online via www.northdevon.gov.uk/localplan and www.torridge.gov.uk/ndtlp. In accordance with the temporary modifications to requirements introduced in response to the coronavirus pandemic, physical copies of the documents will not be made available for inspection.
