The demand for DFG's is increasing, especially with stair lift cases. A significant number of cases have received grant approval but there has been an impact upon the completion of the works. The impact has been both Covid-19 (contractors either not working or limited working) and increase in demand; which will require completion in 2022/23 onwards. The Eco Flexibility Assistance and Warm Up Grants were impacted by Covid-19, resulting in the installers being unable to undertake their normal working practices. This resulted in a reduction of referrals to NDC. However, it is anticipated that 2022/23 onwards will return to the level of referrals previously seen (2019/20 spend on Warm Up Grants was £270k), together with updated eligibility for certain energy measures and targeted marketing. There is also a decision pending to further capitalise officer time to aid with the delivery.

Slippage of some schemes to fit in with delay in delivery programme for these projects. The Disabled Facility Grant scheme will continue to be monitored to ensure we can allocate the full amount of grant allocated to us from the Better Care Fund.
